New solo exhibition by renowned Welsh landscape artist Sarah Jane Brown to evoke memories of the sea

Contemporary Welsh landscape artist Sarah Jane Brown will open a new exhibition of paintings at Off The Wall Gallery in Cardiff, from 27th October until 21st November. Her solo exhibition 'Blurring time and tide' opens at 10am on Saturday 27th October, where there will be the opportunity for visitors to meet Sarah Jane and discuss her work.

Inspired by personal recollections of the coast, Sarah Jane's latest work explores the intense yet fleeting nature of memory and its effect upon the present.

"Thoughts come and go like the reflections of clouds passing by on the wet sand or like the flotsam and jetsam washed over the rocks with the tide. Forgetting the everyday, letting everything go and just absorbing the moment allows memories to come, ephemeral, like the sea washing in and out and leaving marks on the landscape. The details don't matter, what matters is the feeling; the sound of the sea, the gulls, the wind, the smell of the salt in the air, the feel of the elements on your skin, and the thoughts that pass through your head when you're standing on a beach or a cliff top."

Combining a mix of 'old master' and contemporary techniques, Sarah Jane's rich and expressive style uses a variety of methods; staining, glazing and blending in many layers, gradually building up thickness and texture. Conceptually her paintings are an outpouring of personal feeling and a strong sense of place; the landscape becoming a metaphorical vehicle to describe more emotional concerns.

The exhibition takes place at Off The Wall Gallery, a beautifully refined Victorian building situated in Llandaff, Cardiff. Friendly and relaxed, the gallery provides a calm and peaceful space to view Sarah Jane's latest work. Original oil paintings, cards and prints will be available for sale during the exhibition, and can also be purchased online at galleryoffthewall.com.

Sarah Jane has exhibited widely across the UK, and her work is now collected internationally. An Associate Member (AGSA) of The Guild Society of Artists, her notable highlights include exhibiting with the Royal Society of Marine Artists at London's Mall Galleries, and the Royal Cambrian Academy in North Wales.

Upcoming UK events include exhibiting at Off The Wall Gallery's Christmas Show, 22nd November until the New Year. Upcoming international events include exhibiting at the Art Nou Millenni Gallery in Barcelona autumn/winter 2018, exhibiting at the Museum Gustavo Maetzu in Navarra, North West Spain in December 2018, followed by a further show at the Art Nou Millenni Gallery in Barcelona early in 2019.

Current work is also available to view at Etcetera Gallery in St Davids, the Russell Gallery in Putney, and the Discerner Gallery in Mayfair by appointment. For further information please visit www.sjbart.com.

"I carve into 15 layers of luscious Rajasthan silks, fine wools and cottons to create high textile relief panels and art quilts. Some pictures are enhanced with hand embroidery. As a miniature figurative ceramic artist, I explore the drama of the human condition through historical and literary subjects. All pieces are unique; hand built and modelled incorporating strict miniature principles.

I use porcelain fired to the bisque stage, which is then refined before refiring to high porcelain temperatures, which gives the porcelain its luminosity. I often slip cast bases from moulds which I have made myself. The pieces are decorated where appropriate with under glaze, glaze, and lustre.

I exhibit my work nationally and I am an award-winning artist. As an associate member of The Royal Society of Miniature Painters, Sculptors and Gravers, I exhibit annually at the Mall Galleries, London. I’m delighted this year to be a selected artist with The Society of Women Artists, where I have 2 pieces currently on show.

I’m interested in experimenting with colour, texture and abstract landscapes.

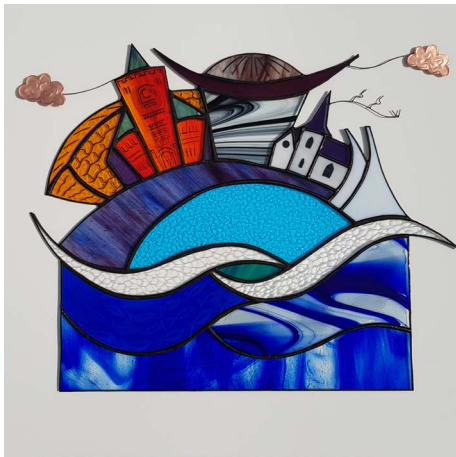
One of my techniques is to use hard rubber lino rollers to pick up textures as acrylic paint, liberally applied, starts to dry and go tacky.

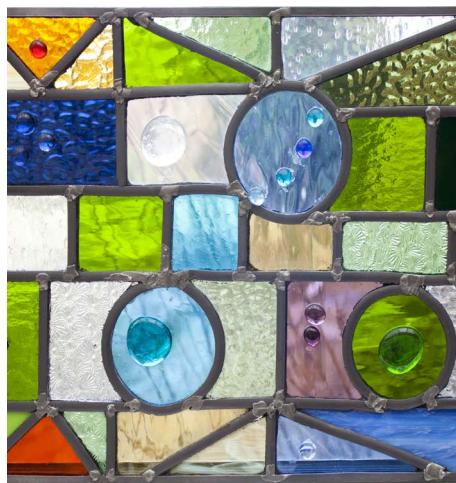

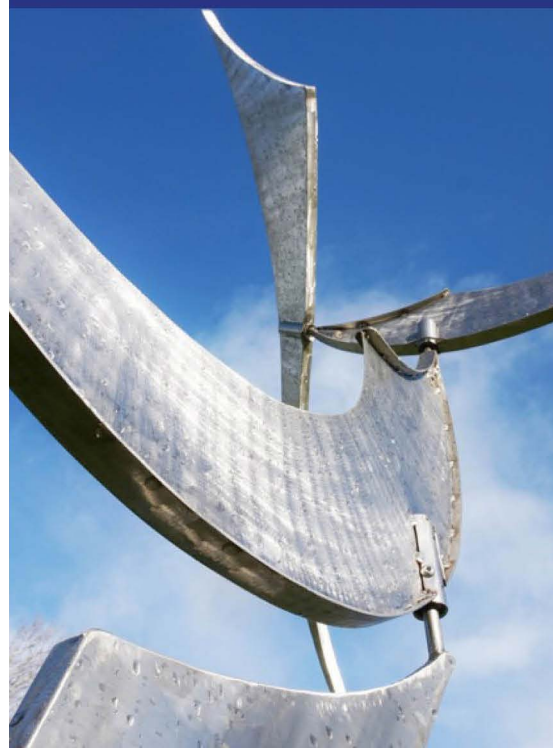

An air of festivity is already creeping into the oriel CRiC gallery in Crickhowell as new work is being added to the autumn exhibition. Alongside the extraordinary array of paintings and prints, the collection of jewellery, ceramics, sculpture and glass is being refreshed for the approaching festive season.

Suzette Pratten said, "Showcasing the art of respected regional and visiting artists has become a hallmark of the oriel CRiC gallery and contributes significantly to the immense enjoyment which visitors to the gallery derive from time spent in the gallery. The autumn exhibition is proving particularly popular with many paintings and prints reflecting the wonderful light of the Welsh landscape this time of the year".

The gallery's reputation for showing beautiful ceramics has been enhanced by the arrival of new work by Jason Braham and Christine Gittins. Working in the Welsh Borders, Jason Braham makes salt-glazed stoneware pottery for use, drawing inspiration from traditional country ware. His jugs, jars and platters, with combed and trailed decoration are particularly inviting and desirable.

The vessels created by Cardiff based Christine Gittins consist of traditional classical shapes presented in a contemporary style. Surfaces are burnished and left for the fire to create colour and markings. She uses a variety of "naked raku" firing techniques for her work.

A new collection of contemporary bronze sculptures by Philip Hearsey sits comfortably alongside these elegant shapes. Philip specialises in sandcasting to make pieces which celebrate the quality of bronze in its own right. Philip says of his work, "I cut, carve, grind or weld the cast bronze to create unique forms before invariably exposing the natural bronze or oxidising to produce the unique surface finishes that have always been an essential dimension of my work. Bronze is eternal - yet malleable. I love the stuff."

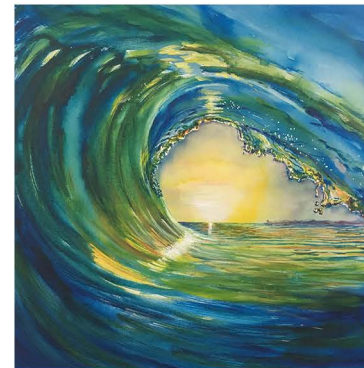

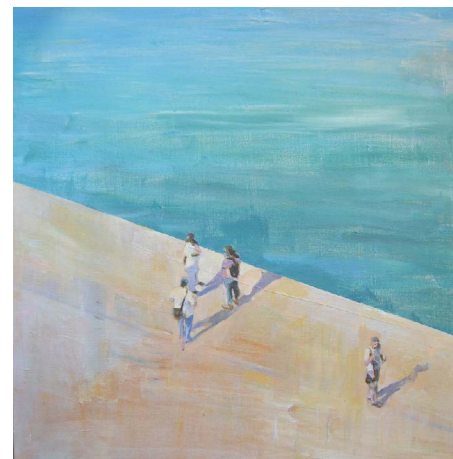
