he worldwide increase in arts and creativity has certainly demonstrated that in difficult times we need art more than ever. It was with great disappointment that the doors to the oriel CRiC gallery temporarily closed in March and both the Crickhowell Open Studios Weekend and Open Art exhibition were cancelled, but It has been wonderful to see how the arts have connected people virtually to a world that was out of their grasp. The gallery staff and volunteers are looking forward to reopening and welcoming visitors in mid-July. The Centre has been prepared with social distancing in mind and visitor numbers will be limited in accordance to Government guidelines. As opening hours will initially be limited, please check @visitcrickhowell and @orielcric on the Social media platforms or email: gallery@visitcrickhow ell.co.uk for opening times. As few people had the opportunity to visit the Spring exhibition and the work of visiting Borth artists, it will be refreshed, but will remain in place for the time being.

Numerous initiatives such as the #artistsupportpledge and Portrait for Heroes started by Oxford based artist Tom Croft show the importance of innovation in times of adversity. He offered to paint a key worker's portrait in a post on Instagram, which has inspired hundreds of artists to paint portraits of frontline workers around the world for free. Oriel CRiC Gallery artists Lee Wright and Paul Burgess have both supported this project by painting poignant portraits.

A6 or 5x7" or 12 x 18cm

Submissions deadline (but not limited to, we will allow for travel and postal delay and restrictions) July 10th

Admission fee £2 per painting.

(This covers admin also and is non refundable, the only reason we would not exhibit a piece is if it exceeds the stated size, is too damaged on arrival at the gallery, or is offensive- we leave the latter to your discretion, art will always be controversial, rightly so, but please try not to be unnecessarily vulgar or grotesque, there will be children viewing this exhibition)

Limited to 5 submissions per person. These will be hung at our discretion. They may be hung apart during the curation, or, if we have a large response, some may be used to fill spaces after any sales. Feel free to tell us your preferred order of display. You may sell your paintings should you wish. Please let us know the desired price for sale. We will not be taking any commission for this exhibition. Only the small administrative and admission fee.

You are welcome to literally send us your work in the form of a postcard if you cannot make it to the gallery, just the cost of a stamp to post! (Please consider some sort of protection to your creation in this instance- eg, envelope) mark all submissions with your name, contact details and if for sale, the price, also title and details of piece. Deliveries can be made to the gallery directly, either during our open hours, or using the front post box or side porch letter box. No submissions will be considered until payment has been made - contact the gallery for this information at:

At the end of the exhibition, wanted paintings not sold must be collected from the gallery by the artist or a designated party, there is no rush to do this if government guidelines do not legally or safely allow it. We will keep them safe.

Found Gallery to re-open on July 14th

Imost exactly a year on from when they first opened Found Gallery on the Bulwark is re-opening on Tuesday, July 14th with an exhibition entitled Found by the Sea featuring marine artist Nick John Rees.

Through his friendship with Sir Kyffin Williams, Nick was encouraged to paint professionally and has subsequently enjoyed doing so for over 20 years. Over lunch in his local Kyffin Williams counselled Nick to paint what he loves & that that passion would come through in his work; Nick has focussed upon his life long love of the sea ever since.

Alongside Nick's paintings Found is welcoming back potter, Nigel Lambert with his slip decorated woodfired earthenware. His thrown and altered pots combine bold contemporary shapes, with his unique style of decoration and strong sense of function.

Yvette Brown will be showing some of her charming pewter characters on driftwood. Her Christmas themed ones were very popular in the gallery's Seasonal Finds exhibition and her 'dog walking on the beach' montages will be equally successful.

The re-opening of the gallery will also offer visitors the chance of seeing the work close up of another potter, Nick Membery, whose work has been 'in the windows' for the last couple of months.

Other work will be by Ceredigion based 'Beachcomber' jeweller, Kerry Hughes along with Herefordshire based 'artist blacksmith', Jacob Edwards. Jacob graduated from Hereford Art College in 2019 a year when he also won The Stanley Allcard Memorial Trophy, The Lion Gallery Award, The Nertherton Award and The Bernard and Catherine Gay Award for Outstanding Creativity.

The lower gallery at Found will not be open initially.

Opening hours will be 10am – 3pm, Tuesday – Saturday.
