As a printmaker living in Wales I love walking through the natural and industrial landscape and find it inspiring for the design of my original prints.

To create each new print, I work first on the design using my own photographs and sketches. Then I transfer my design directly onto lino and hand-carve the images using Pfeil tools. Next, with a roller, I apply Cranfield Caligo inks



directly to the lino. Then, I lay Somerset Satin paper over the lino and print by hand using the back of a metal spoon. Finally, I name and sign each print by hand.

Drawing is a big part of the process and each design is carefully thought out. Colour is also important and is inspired by vintage prints. The ideas are then translated onto the lino block. The prints are made using the reduction method, colour is applied with a roller, paper is placed over the top, then each print is hand burnished. The paper is lifted to reveal the image.


