Drawing inspiration from the majestic, rugged coastline around the Isle of Harris, Belinda uses white stoneware and porcelain to make decorative and functional ceramics reflecting her love of the colours and textures of the Island's coastline. She has formulated a palette of glazes with contrasting textures. The volcanic areas are ground down to reveal the bubbling, dry texture beneath, these eroded areas contrast with the watery, fluid glazes as the sea foaming on the rocks. 

"Ensemble i.a.t.B" in the Dog House – jazz and other genres - eclectic.






"Jarzino" in the Bell Marquee – soul, pop, reggae, rock – the Gurus of Groove.
