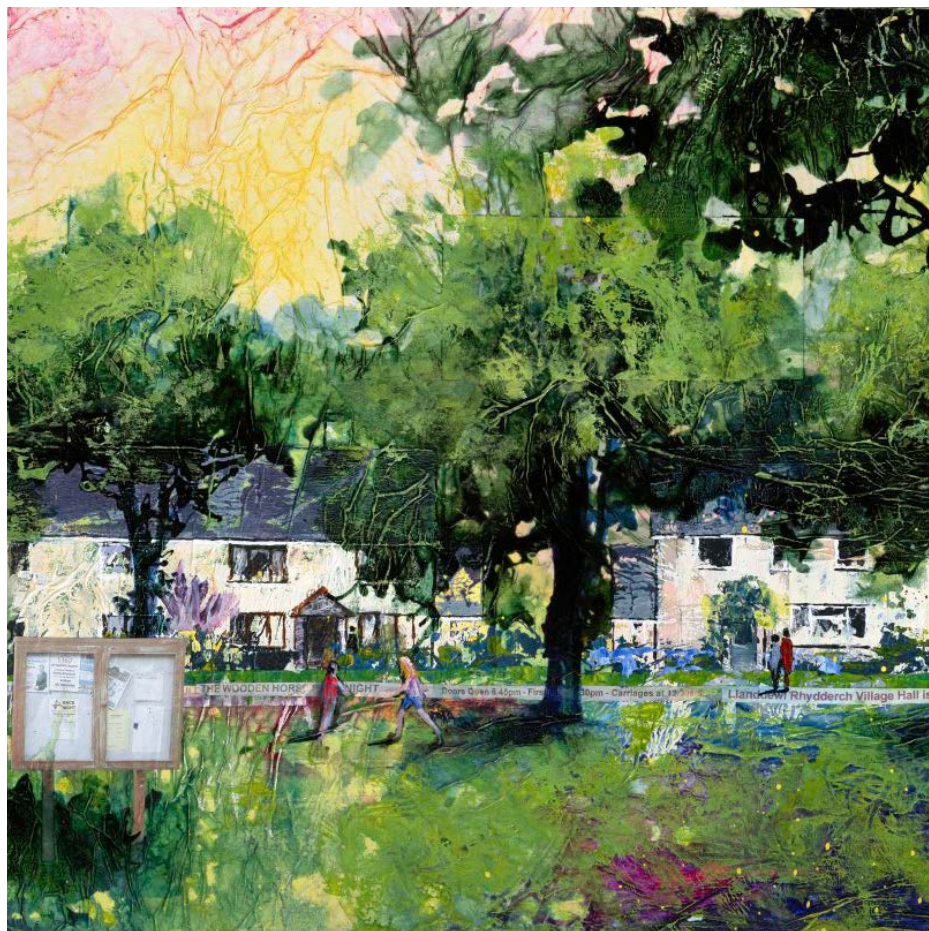

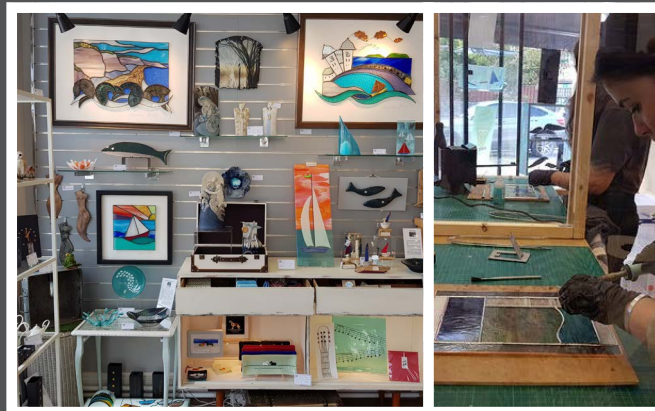

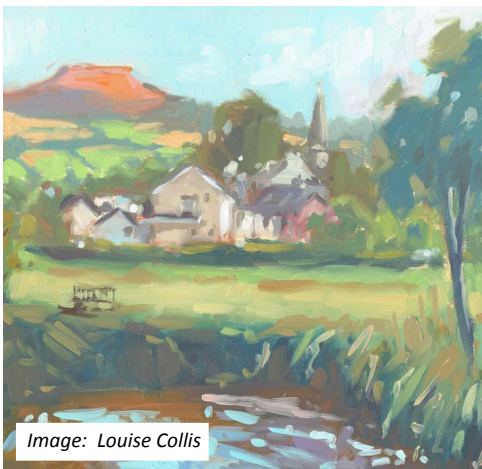

The translucency and beauty of the irises in oil on linen by Martin Truefitt-Baker epitomises the lightness of spirit and renewed appreciation that visitors to the gallery are experiencing as it has increased its opening to six days per week (Monday to Saturday 10am to 3pm). Martin started this painting during the weekend that would have been the Crickhowell Open Studios weekend in May and as such it is with great delight that two paintings of irises by Martin which reflect his skill at capturing colour and form without losing spontaneity have been added to the summer exhibition.

The summer exhibition will continue until early September and is being refreshed with new work on a weekly basis. A new collection of burnished pots by Christine Gittins sit very comfortably next to oil paintings by Louise Collis who has added vibrant views of Table Mountain and Llangorse lake to her collection of work already in the gallery. Louise never disappoints with her colourful and vibrant paintings, which capture the atmosphere of Welsh landscapes so well.

With visitors returning to the landscape of the Brecon Beacons and Black Mountains seeing the art that it inspires adds to the experience. The gallery's mix of ceramics, glass, jewellery, textiles and sculpture makes it an ideal place to appreciate and enjoy exceptional creativity in a beautiful space. You can find her work at Glass By Design in Penarth, which is a studio gallery she co-owns. She also teaches fused glass techniques from here.

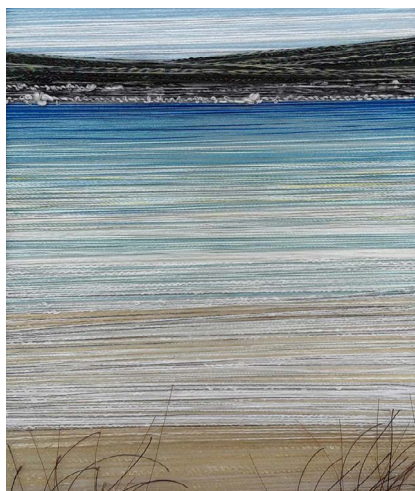
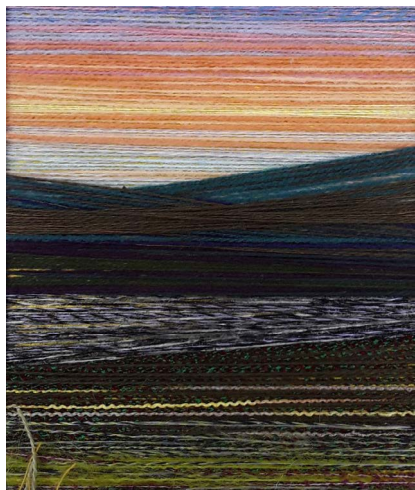

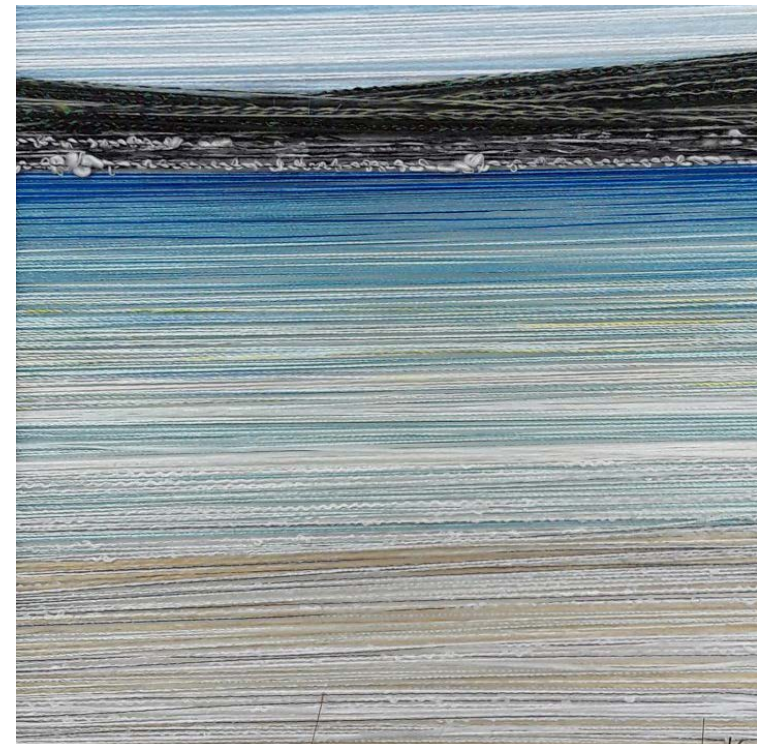

We have planned our Autumn programme with some new measures in place to allow us to comply with social distancing at the Studio. We will be reducing our maximum number of students per class from 12 down to 6 to allow everyone their own table to work on. We will also have several other measures in place such as hand sanitizers, a one way in and out system to avoid busy areas and of course stringent cleaning procedures to ensure everything is as safe as possible to welcome you back.
