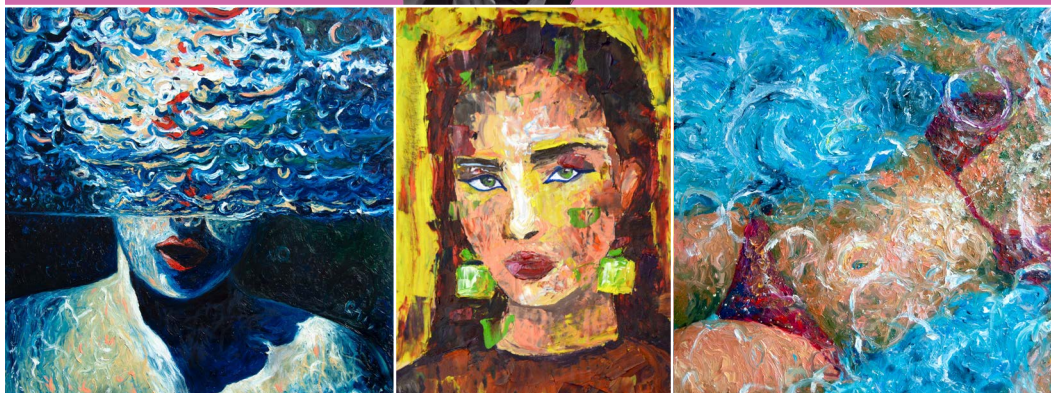

"By using my fingers I feel in contact with the paint and the canvas in a very pleasant way and I am in full control of the colour. I've always been in a constant search for something new and for a technique that I could perform well while being able to communicate with my audience. I've had to be able to master all of the basic painting techniques and mediums, then I tried FINGER PAINTING and something clicked and I realized that it was the right style for me."

When asking what inspires her art, Chiara says, "I listen to my muse and like to observe my day to day life and see what colours and scenarios Mother nature has to offer, that is the best way for me to stay inspired. Everything that I see that might be a good subject for a painting, then gets elaborated and filtered by my mind and view point in such a way I can really put my personality and my touch on each

painting".

Chiara's Art will be in display in Zurich from December at the Ethnicity Art Gallery and from the end of November a collection of her paintings will be in display at the Apartment Art Gallery, which is at 31 Revenscroft Rd, London, W4 5EQ.

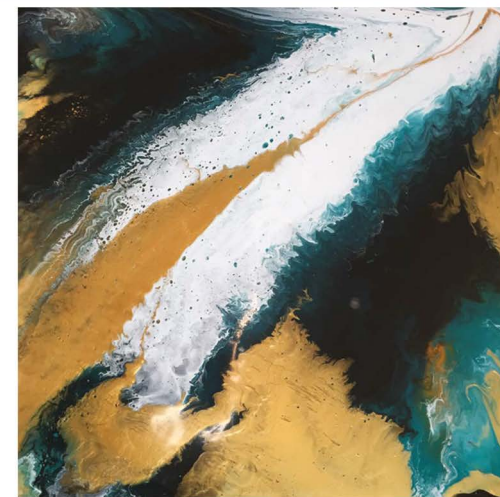

Creating abstract free-flowing art with immense detail and texture, Amy Salisbury is breaking boundaries, with new and exciting methods to create her unique and striking work.

This extraordinary method, which yields incredible results, is created using a combination of acrylic paint, a variety of additives and often the application of heat. Then by spreading the paint and tilting the surface, this gives the 'flow' effect and creates Amy's signature style.

"I am happiest when I'm in my studio, whether working with a paintbrush or creating different effects with other materials. Getting up the next morning to see how the paints have developed overnight is incredible. If I could film every tiny movement in slow motion I would."

Amy is Inspired by nature - especially the underwater world (see her Blue Planet collection) and also outer space and the photography taken by NASA!

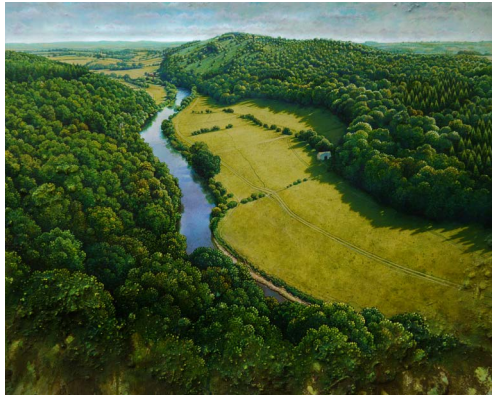

On closer inspection one can see small fragments of leaves, seeds and other organic matter within this 'living painting medium'. Mixed media and gouache painting capture the exquisite and highly detailed beauty.

From university to commercial illustrator working for clients such as Punch magazine and the Radio Times, Warren has spent the last 24 years as a fully qualified Art and Design teacher. He lives in the Forest of Dean with his family where he tutors in an exciting local arts centre and works from his studio located on the edge of the forest.

Ever since the first induction into the hot glass workshop, I have fallen in love with the material. I am fascinated by the fluidity of hot glass and the control required to work with it. I particularly enjoy allowing the material to dictate the form of the pieces in a natural way. I also find the effect colour can have on the form of a piece extremely interesting. These pieces have been developed through experimenting with layering different colours both solid, and frit, to see how it affects the final form. I am inspired by the concept of urban decay. The way man made structures become forgotten about and left to Mother Nature to reclaim. I plan to continue exploring the way glass dictates its final form in a natural way, and also how I can further express the reclamation of urban spaces by Mother Nature.

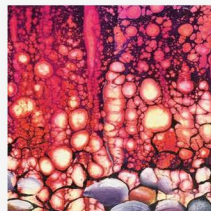
