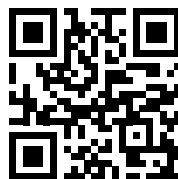

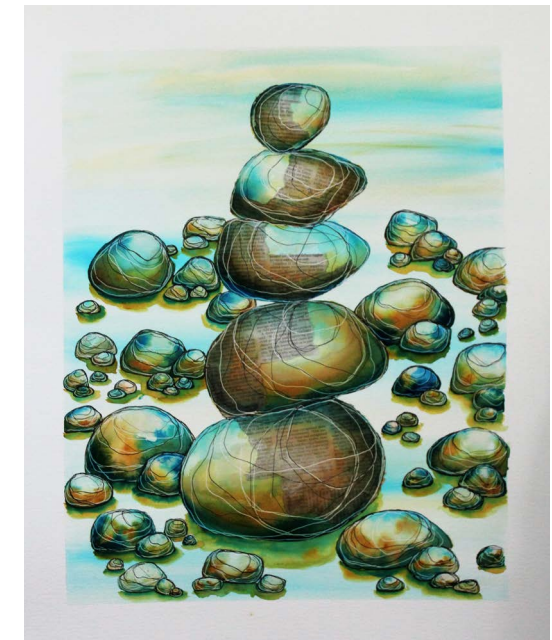

The bar at Elmslie will be transformed into a cafe for the day, offering a selection of home-made cakes and light refreshments.

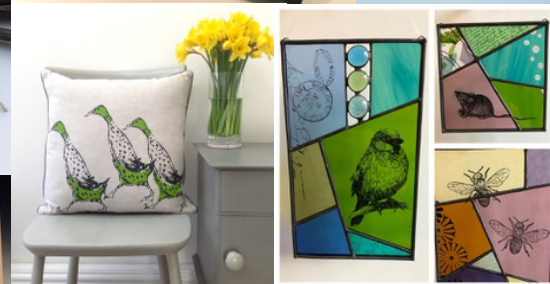
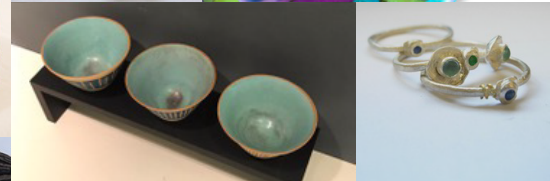

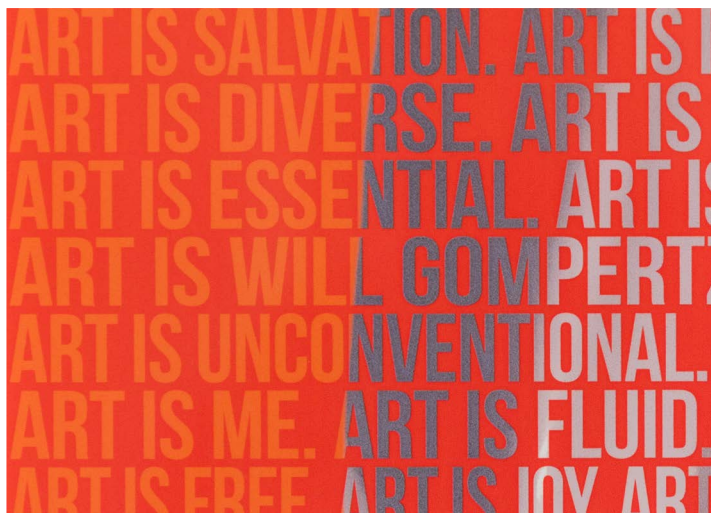

Guy Manning's Art Room, Tenby

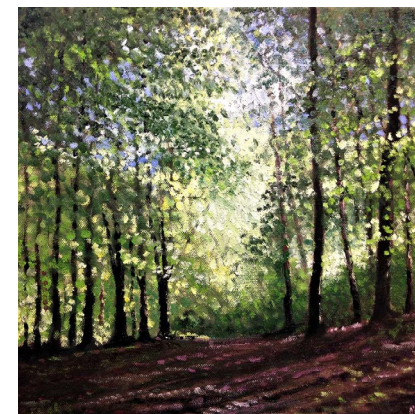
Guy is a landscape painter in love with West Wales and its beaches, rural lanes, magnificent woodlands and quiet fields. His oil paintings are a celebration of light and reflect his love of where he grew up and his time studying the Impressionists. Over the years Guy has exhibited across the UK, France, Germany and the US.

In March 2018, Guy opened his Art Room in Brychan Yard in Tenby's historic centre. This is his studio where he makes and sells paintings and runs inspiring classes for students of all levels. It very much has an “art room” feel to it, with canvases being stretched, lots of works at different stages and also, of course, lots of Guy's beautiful paintings.

“I opened the Art Room in March 2018, just as the ice and snow arrived! I always wanted a space where I could paint, sell and teach and this is perfect. It is busy, informal, serious and fun all at once. I love painting, I never tire of it. With my classes I try to establish a “can-do” culture: it really is just paint on a surface, the more one tries, the more one learns; the more one learns, the more magic appears. Mistakes and practice combine very well, and a few tips and tricks go a long way...”

The gallery welcomes browsers, buyers, children, dogs and wellies. Commissions are welcomed although there is usually a bit of a waiting list.

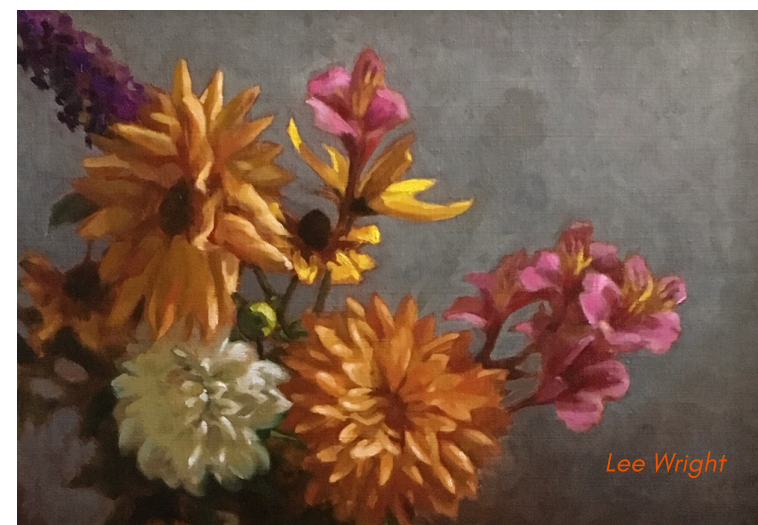

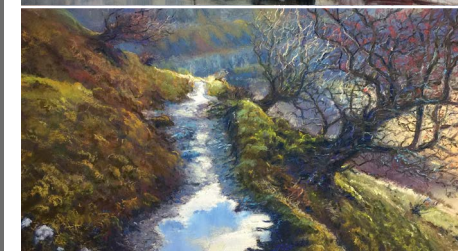

DEBBIE JONES-ROBERTS

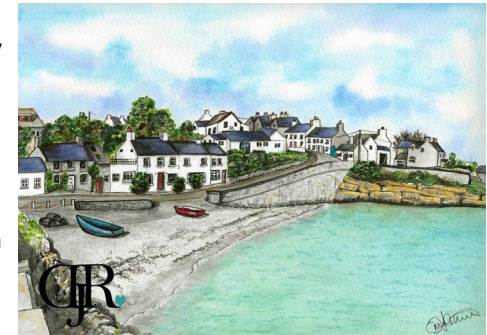
A Welsh painter from North Wales. Many of my paintings are of all the places in Wales that are very special to me. I begin with ink, and then bring the painting to life with watercolour.

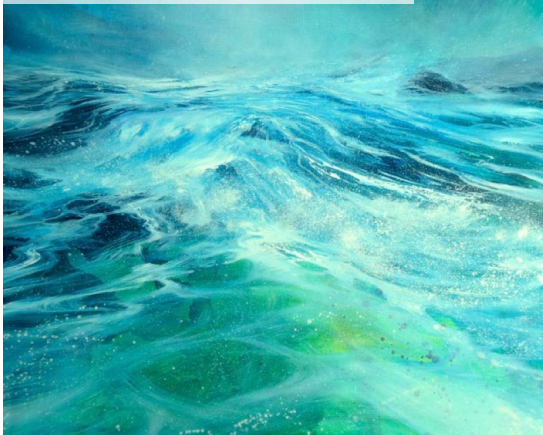

Printing

All prints are produced using a Cannon IPF 8400 with the 12 colour Lucia EX pigment ink system, coupled with a range of Hahnemuhle fine art papers. There is no minimum print order and prints are usually ready for collection / shipping within 48 hrs.

Print discounts are available depending on the quantity of prints ordered and the prints can be any combination of design or size to qualify.
