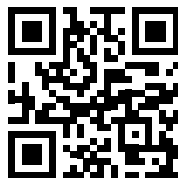

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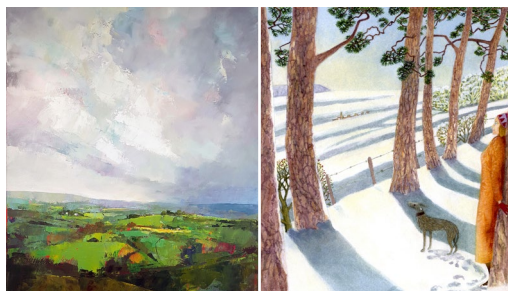

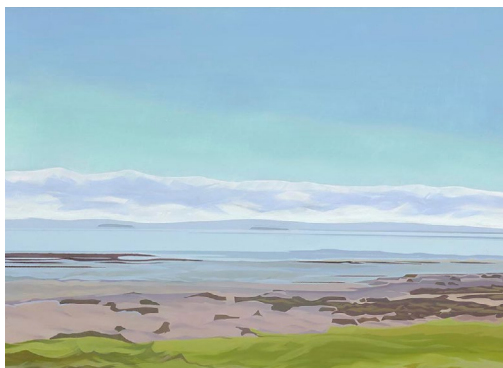

Glen tries to show regrowth, hope and love in his sculptures despite its dire beginnings.

Having exhibited all over the world, Glen is now living in stunning North Wales, where he continues to work with reclaimed, abandoned and discarded Welsh materials uncovering their beauty.

Made with consideration and care, they are the antidote to the world of the mass-produced - an opportunity to stop and enjoy the moment.



My stoneware pieces range from platters, beakers and bowls to more decorative items such as stem vases, soap dishes and candlesticks. I choose to handbuild rather than throw on the wheel. In this way, the pieces evolve more organically, following the Japanese principle of wabi sabi or 'beauty in imperfection'.
