Penallt Art Festival – Art in Action

The Art in Penallt team in the scenic hillside village just south of Monmouth in the delightful Wye Valley have once again put a formidable group of artists and makers together to showcase their works between 22nd and 25th September. The event is now in its 6th year; more than 500 people attended last year and we hope that 2016 will be even better.

Over the past 6 years, over 100 leading local and international artists and makers have exhibited over the four days of the festival and sales are always consistently high. Curator Ann Bradbury has now sifted applications for this year's show and has been developing a theme for the event. Demonstrators have also been lined up to add colour and further interest to the event and will be performing in marquees in the adjacent Babington Meadow Arena on the Saturday and Sunday.

Selecting exhibitors is never an easy task and to ensure that each year the show brings in exciting new blood the team normally does not select exhibitors for more than two consecutive years. This sometimes makes for tough choices.

The Festival is centred on Capel Pentwyn, it is an imaginatively converted Arts and Crafts period church at the heart of the village, a small well lit building with excellent wall space, which is transformed once a year from a luxury holiday home into an art gallery. Alongside is Babington Meadow, a novel ecological park in the middle of the village, which becomes a further area for display and demonstrations by artists and makers under large marquees. The two adjacent sites complement each other, the chapel being a calm, quiet space full of interesting, original artwork whilst the Meadow is an animated centre of action and creativity.

The show opens on the evening of Thursday 22nd September with a free drinks reception in Cape Pentwyn where the public can meet the artists. On the Friday there is a special exhibition of students work from the Monmouth Schools with the proceeds of sales split between the artists and this year's charity – Bridges Community Centre in Monmouth. There will also be art courses in Pelham Hall run on the Sunday led by Richard Wills, a well known local artist. On the Saturday, Humble by Nature will also run a special course – last year this sold out very quickly so advance booking is essential.

The main exhibition in Capel Pentwyn runs all the way through to Sunday 25th and is open from 10 to 4. Demonstrations and further exhibits will be on show in Babington Meadow on both the Saturday and the Sunday and there will be a refreshment terrace serving delicious locally prepared snacks and drinks. Of course the highly regarded Inn at Penallt is just around the corner for those making a day of it.

A windfall opportunity arose recently with an invitation from the Welsh National Eisteddfod organisers to stage a Penallt Art Festival preview exhibition in the main pavilion of the Eisteddfod in Abergavenny between the 2nd and 6th August. More than 150,000 visitors are expected. It's been a lot of hard work to put this showcase event together quickly, which has also stretched the team's Welsh language skills!

Art in Penallt is a not for profit organisation whose aim is to organise an annual art festival in the village of Penallt. The festival organisers are all local volunteers and work in partnership with Babington Meadow, a registered charity, and have also developed a close association with Made in Monmouthshire and local secondary schools. The purpose is to stimulate interest and enthusiasm amongst all age groups in the artistic process of creating a broad range of art and craft forms and to sell a wide variety of high quality artwork.

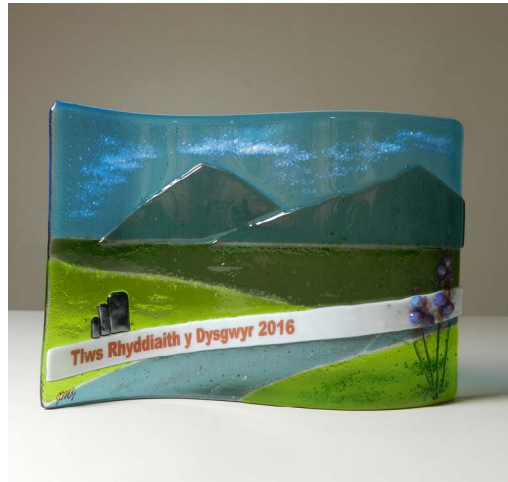

Pop artist Richard Blacklaw-Jones' art is soon to be sharing his sustainable mixed media artworks at the Moma Machynlleth Gallery. 'Beachcomber' Richard gathers his treasure from beaches across England and Wales.

Seeing art in disused objects is Richard's passion. From metals to glass and plastics, eroded and weathered by nature, some glistening in the sunshine, enticing Richard's inner creative self to collect and reproduce it into a masterpiece to be appreciated by art lovers.

Spending literally hours sometimes in search of what nature may bring him, this sustainable art form is Richards's self-sufficient way of not only giving back to nature but also driving his need to create and make.

With many years of beachcombing under his belt, Richard's work has evolved to a more abstract mixed

media art, with messages of its materials origins and journey from production to disregard.

Using their natural colours, shape, forms and sometimes text, Richard creates abstract meaning in each of his art works. In combining and essentially cleaning beaches of its unwanted washed-up debris, Richard's intriguing art is every bit environmentally friendly and plays on its original use.

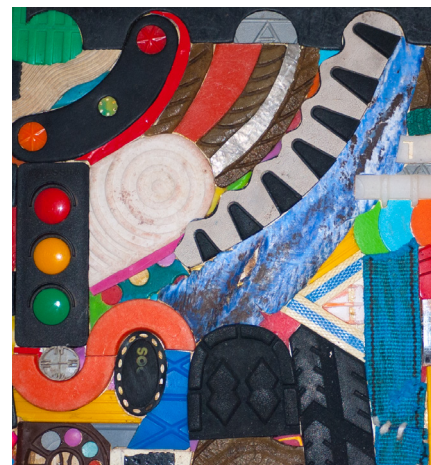

Barry Arnold is an artist who has lived in Pontgarreg, Ceredigion for 35 years with his wife, Christine who is also an artist working in textiles, felt, paper and mixed media. Living close to the rugged coastline with stunning surrounding countryside, the seascape, landscape, farms and buildings have proved a source of unlimited inspiration for his paintings.

Barry and Chris are both canal enthusiasts and spend a lot of time on their narrow boat on the Monmouthshire & Brecon Canal, which again provides stunning scenery viewed differently with every passing season. Edging toward 'retirement' age, Barry has more time now to explore and experiment with painting and is producing work that is more relaxed and representative of how the countryside 'feels', rather than looks. Blending colours subconsciously and refining his palette, his work shows its own style and originality.

With heart and a passion for capturing moments past, Barry's work is nothing short of brilliant. There is a warmth and tranquillity found in every piece. A calming affect as you delve into what feels like his soul.

Barry works mainly with acrylic paint on board rather than canvas. Image sizes are usually A4 or less.

Occasionally however, a subject may suddenly appear that will engage him to produce larger works of any size. He does not accept commissions.

"I like to share my work publicly and I am engaging this year with the Taith Celf Ceredigion Art Trail. I am hopeful that people will come and view some of my paintings, many of which will be for sale. I am also producing some limited edition prints, which I will be offering at substantially reduced prices for the duration of the trail event, which runs from 30th July – 14th August. I will be doing more teaching and running courses from my home in Pontgarreg. Classes will be tailored to all abilities, particularly to encourage those who want to get started or progress further or for those who merely enjoy working alongside others."

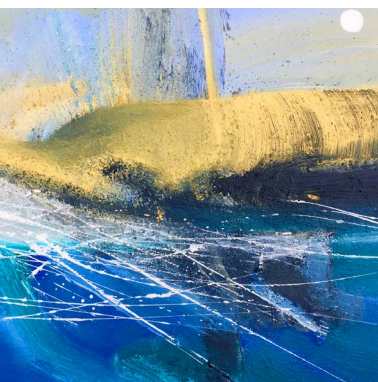

Coastal spirit is an ongoing series and new body of work inspired by the coast and sea. These new paintings from Dorian Spencer Davies, are expressive semi-abstract work

based on the coastal spirit of his beloved West Wales where he grew up. He uses a variety of media including oil, acrylic and even sand from the beaches visited, which contain some of the spirit and texture of the coastal landscape.

“I’ve mixed and developed my trademark ‘blue’ using various raw pigments, oils and other mediums and I find this very exciting. The texture within the work gives them another added dimension and some almost look as if they’ve been left out in the elements to weather with salty winds and spray”
